What are the dates of the DRL – Foundation Program and the Institute?

- DRL officially starts with a casual Meet & Greet on Wednesday November 9 at 4 p.m. You can pick up your Registration materials at that time. DRL Programming starts on Thursday morning at 8:30 am.
- The Institute begins Thursday night, November 10, with the District Governor Elect Presentation Dinner, and will be very special. The Institute has a hands-on project for all participants on Friday, programming all day Saturday and then Sunday morning. It ends around noon on Sunday, November 13.

When should I arrive and depart from Santa Barbara?

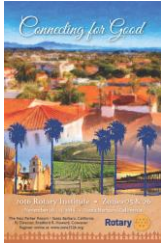
- Arrive no later than Wednesday November 9. Return home after the conclusion of the Institute on November 13. *Most people will be staying over on Sunday night. There will be Host Hospitality Events on Sunday, so staying until Monday, November 14 will allow you to participate in these events*

As a DRL, for what do I need to register?

1. The DRL/Institute Registration \$270 (which includes lunch on Thursday)
2. Your hotel room (directly with the hotel)
3. The Institute meal plan \$295
5. Any host hospitality events that don't compete with DRL programming

When should I register for the hotel (Fess Parker Santa Barbara Hotel)? Is the cost of the hotel part of the DRL & Institute registrations?

- The cost of the hotel is entirely separate from your Institute and DRL registrations. The hotel is accepting reservations now and we strongly encourage you to lock in your hotel stay ASAP!
- To reserve your room [reserve online here](#), or call (877) 893-0892 to reserve. Please, make your hotel reservations immediately, to make sure you have a room when you need it.
- If you wish to come early or stay late for vacation, the hotel will offer the Rotary discounted special room rates from October 31st to the night of November 18, 2016. The discounted rates are good for reservations booked by October 21, 2016.

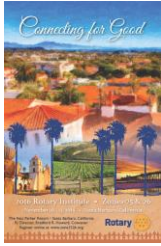
What recreational and vacation opportunities will be available and when are they? Will they interfere with DRL? When/how do I register?

- DGE presentation on Thursday night is formal (black tie optional)
- Business Attire for Saturday dinner
- Jeans or casual attire for an outdoor project on Friday (this is for ALL Institute attendees). T-shirts will be on sale for this project.
- IF you have been on a Polio NID, please bring your NID yellow jacket or similar attire.

If I drive, what is the cost of parking at the hotel?

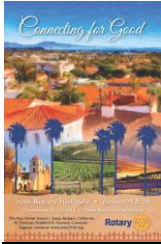
- We have discounted parking: \$10 per night with in-and-out privileges.
