Denver Airport Arrival Details:

How do I get to the main terminal from my gate? NOTE: A major construction project will be underway at the airport during the Institute, so please allow for unanticipated changes during arrival and departure.

Denver International Airport utilizes underground trains from each concourse to access the main terminal and baggage claim. Follow signs to main terminal and baggage claim.

Will Rotarians greet us at the airport?

Yes, upon exiting from the underground trains, look for the Rotary banner and red-vested Rotarians at the top of the escalators when entering the main terminal. If you should arrive at an unusual time, there may not be a Rotarian on duty.

Denver Airport Departure Details:

Main Terminal Configuration:

Departing passengers arrive at either the east or west sides of the Jeppesen Terminal via Peña Boulevard, the airport roadway. The roadway divides to Terminal East and Terminal West depending upon airline, but also separates into three traffic levels for greater convenience and less traffic congestion:

- LEVEL 6: DEPARTURES – Departing passengers, curbside baggage check-in and airline ticketing
- LEVEL 5: TAXI, VAN and SHUTTLE SERVICES – Drop-off and pick-up lanes for taxis, car-rental vans, shuttles, buses, limousines. THIS LEVEL IS ALSO BAGGAGE CLAIM.
- LEVEL 4: ARRIVALS – Passenger pick-up. DOWN ONE LEVEL FROM BAGGAGE CLAIM.

Transportation:

How do I get to the hotel?

Light Rail: \$10.50 (\$5.25 senior over 65) one way. This requires a train change and takes about one hour. The hotel is about two blocks from the Belleview Light Rail Station. The hotel provides a first come first serve shuttle from/to this nearby station. Call hotel at (303) 779-1100 Ext 7.

Uber/Lyft: \$35-\$55 one way, depending time of day. Use Uber or Lyft apps or call:

Commercial Cab: \$62+. Use Curb apps or call

For shared ride services, rates vary but generally are \$30 -\$50 one way, depending on reserved or non-reserved, total passengers, etc. See airport website for more information:

Rental Car: Shuttles from main terminal (LEVEL 5 BAGGAGE CLAIM) to all major rental companies.

Will transportation be provided from the hotel to the airport on Sunday?

We are arranging bus transport from the hotel on Sunday to the airport for \$15 per person. Registration for airport return will occur on your Institute registration page via the Zone website. No other airport-hotel transportation will be provided.
